5.2 Adoption of Green Technology (GT) (QL)

Mahatma Gandhi College, Iritty has taken significant steps towards creating an environmentally responsible campus by adopting various green technologies and sustainable practices. Guided by the principles of conservation, ecological balance, and responsible resource management, the institution integrates green initiatives into academic, administrative, and infrastructural systems. These efforts not only reduce environmental impact but also inculcate eco-conscious values among students and staff.

One of the key green technologies implemented on the campus is the **solar energy system**, which supplements the institution's electricity requirements. The installation of solar panels helps reduce dependence on conventional power sources and minimizes carbon emissions. This shift to renewable energy is a crucial step toward a cleaner and more sustainable future. The college also promotes energy-efficient practices by using **LED lighting**, energy-saving equipment, and encouraging responsible usage among campus stakeholders.

The institution has adopted a **rainwater harvesting system**, ensuring optimal use and conservation of water resources. Collected rainwater is channelled for groundwater recharge and non-potable purposes, thereby reducing the load on external water supply systems. Additionally, the campus promotes water conservation through leak-proof plumbing, low-flow fixtures, and regular maintenance checks.

Solid waste management is another area where the college has incorporated green technology. The campus follows a **segregated waste disposal system**, which separates biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. Biodegradable waste is processed using **vermicomposting units**, producing nutrient-rich compost that is used for maintaining the campus garden and greenery. The college also encourages a plastic-free environment by promoting reusable materials and conducting awareness drives against single-use plastics.

Mahatma Gandhi College, Iritty has also implemented **green landscaping technologies**, including organic gardening and extensive tree plantation efforts. The campus maintains a green belt with native plant species, which helps regulate microclimate, reduces air pollution, and enhances biodiversity. The use of organic manure instead of chemical fertilizers further reflects the commitment to eco-friendly practices.

In recent years, the institution has incorporated **ICT-enabled green practices** to reduce paper consumption. The use of digital platforms for communication, documentation, and learning—such as online submissions, digital attendance, Learning Management Systems, and e-content—minimizes paper waste and supports an eco-friendly academic culture. Administrative processes have also shifted toward e-governance, significantly reducing physical documentation.
